



FAREWELL “CHAMPAGNE” FLIGHT BRITISH AIRWAYS’ BOEING 757

British Airways retires its last Boeing 757-200s from passenger service on 31st October, ending another chapter in British civil aviation history.

BA, along with Eastern Airlines in the USA, were the first to operate the sleek, Rolls Royce powered ‘pocket rocket’, in 1983.
